CALL FOR ENTRIES

The Liberal Arts Network for Development (LAND) is sponsoring a competition to exhibit a Fine Arts Competition to be held in February, 2010 at the LAND Conference hosted by SCCCC, composed of all 28 community colleges in Michigan. The purpose of the conference is to provide educational experiences for community college faculty and administrators interested in the liberal arts: English, History, Philosophy, Foreign Languages, Art, Music, Theatre, Dance, Anthropology, Sociology, Psychology, Geography, Mathematics, and Science. The focus of the conference is to network educators with current trends and teaching in the liberal arts.

THE 25th ANNUAL LAND CONFERENCE

- FINE ARTS THEME:** **Eye or Eyes**
- CONFERENCE DATES:** February 17,18,19, 2010
- SPECIFICATIONS:** A Color Xerox or Print (not the original), Black & White or Full Color, 8x10 inches Vertical or Horizontal Format, Mounted on 12x14 inch black board
- THEME:** **Eye or Eyes**, any concept or image, no matter how remote which has the concept of cloud or clouds. It may be a symbol, pattern, realistic, or your interpretation of the theme.
- DUE DATE:** January 15, 2010
- LOCATION:** **Thomas Edison Inn**
- PRIZES** First prize - \$200 Second prize - \$100 Third prize - \$50
In addition to cash awards, a selected number of entries will receive Honorable Mention Certificates.
- JUDGING CRITERIA** Entries will be juried by an art professional to determine prize winners
Entries will be evaluated for the originality, creativity, and quality of the concept of how effectively the idea relates to the theme. Design and craftsmanship will also be a part of the decision.
- ARTIST/ DESIGNER RELEASE** By submission of artwork, the student artist grants permission to LAND to reproduce (without further remuneration) any selected artwork. The student also attests to the originality of the design submitted. Student Information should be legible form (and may be typed) so the student can be contacted if needed. The form must also have a faculty or administrator's signature to verify student's eligibility.
